Dear Sir / Madam,

As you must be aware, the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR-a central autonomous body under the DSIR, Min. of Science & Technology) through the CSIR-Human Resource Development Group (HRDG) has been implementing several Res. Fellowship/Associateship schemes, under which financial assistance is provided to **CSIR-Researchers**, viz. (JRF/SPMF/SRF/RA/SRAs/CSIR-Nehru PDF, etc.) to pursue research in various fields of science and technology.

I would like to inform you that vide O.M No I-11011/58/2013-DBT dated February 13, 2015 and 19th February 2015, all Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes, both plan and non-Plan, where cash benefits are transferred to individual beneficiaries implemented through Centre / State/ Government's Implementing agencies/ Societies, have been brought under the ambit of Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) and Public Financial Management System (PFMS). Both DBT and PFMS are platforms set up by the Govt. of India to monitor and to facilitate smoother and faster fund-transfer directly to intended beneficiaries. Both the platforms are operational and increasingly being used by all Ministries and agencies.

With a view to on-board these platforms, as per the GOI directives it is required that records of all beneficiaries who are availing fellowships and other types of financial assistance are digitized and mapped scheme-wise under PFMS / DBT as mandated by the Government of India.

CSIR has since initiated steps to onboard PFMS/DBT platform and would be releasing the funds only through PFMS/ DBT platforms to the Scheme beneficiaries with effect from January 2017. You are requested to kindly make note of the change and arrange to send us the details of beneficiaries as per enclosed format (also downloadable from www.csirhrdg.res.in). A soft copy of beneficiary database, as per enclosed format, may be mailed to : dbt@csirhrdg.res.in, and a hard copy of the same along with supporting documents, duly certified by authorized signatory/ies of your respective Institution may be sent to the Sci. In-Charge (EMR-I), CSIR HRDG, Oppo. Hotel Mngt. Building, Pusa, New Delhi-110012; so as to reach us latest by 31st October, 2016 for further n/a at our end.

It may be reiterated that the CSIR will not be able to release the grant on account of fellowship to the beneficiary Institutions from Jan 2017 onwards, unless the information as requested is submitted to CSIR – HRDG by the stipulated date; for which the Grantee-Institutions and their concerned Fellow(s) themselves shall be responsible .
