Sub: Reiteration of CSIR guidelines vis-à-vis CSIR fellowships/associateships

Madam/Sir,

Attention is invited to the various guidelines available on the CSIR HRDG website vis-à-vis the fellowships/associateships offered by CSIR. Even as CSIR HRDG has been constantly publishing advisories to sensitize the stakeholders about the compliance/procedural aspects of the CSIR guidelines, it has been observed that the concerned stakeholders viz. the CSIR fellows/associates/Nodal Officers of the Host Universities/Institutes/Colleges repeat the same mistakes while submitting applications/claims on the portals of CSIR. This leads to delay in disbursement of the fellowships to the concerned individuals, resulting in increase of grievances/complaints.

In order to resensitize the stakeholders, following advisory pertaining to various issues being faced is issued for information, guidance and strict compliance of all concerned:

Submission of Fellowship claims on Fellow AMS portal	a) The Fellows/Associates submit the fellowship claims, after completion of one year from the termination/completion of their fellowships/associateship's tenure. b) Certain host Universities/Institutes don't allow the fellows/associates to submit their pending fellowship claims on the portal, or forward the same to CSIR, on completion of their tenure/termination of their fellowship/associateship, for want of No Dues Certificate.	a) The fellows/associates must settle all their pending claims within one year from the date of termination/completion of their fellowship/associateship's tenure. b) This is not the correct practice and is not in conformity with the CSIR guidelines. The host Universities/Institutes must not withhold the pending fellowship claims of their fellows/associates just due to non-submission of No Dues Certificate. They are advised to devise some mechanism to ensure that no dues remain unrecovered from their fellows/associates, if required but any pending claims must be forwarded to CSIR within the prescribed one-year time-limit.
9.	Updates on the Fellow AMS after approval on the New FMS portal	a) The Fellows/Associates/Nodal Officers of the host Universities/Institutes keep sending emails to CSIR HRDG for updates on Fellow AMS immediately on approval of any processes like new joining, extension, continuation/upgradation etc.	a) This is not the correct practice. It usually takes at least 5 working days to update the profile of a fellow/associate after approval on the New FMS portal. The Fellows/Associates/Nodal officers are advised to wait at least for 5 working days after approval on the New FMS portal and to raise a concern only if the

			updates don't take place within 5 working days.
10.	Submitting resignations on the New FMS portal	<p>a) Fellows/Associates/Nodal Officers submit the resignations on the New FMS portal after a gap of many days/months from the effective date of resignation and then face issues in doing so, as the portal does not allow submission of resignation from a retrospective date.</p> <p>b) On many occasions, the resignation application is not supported by the signed application containing specific reasons with specific date of resignation.</p>	<p>a) They must, once the date of their resignation is finalized, submit the resignation on the portal on the very day of resignation, i.e. the effective date of resignation on the New FMS portal. This means that the Fellow/Associate must submit the resignation application on the New FMS portal on the same day of resignation from which she/he is tendering resignation.</p> <p>b) The Fellow/Associate while submitting resignation on the New FMS portal must upload a signed copy of the resignation, specifying the reasons and effective date of resignation, duly forwarded by the Guide/Research Supervisor.</p>

The above suggestions are advisory in nature and must not be construed as the substitute to the original guidelines displayed on the CSIR HRDG website, as amended from time to time. In case of any dispute, the original guidelines displayed on the CSIR HRDG website shall prevail.
