- The date of declaration result of Joint CSIR-UGC NET Examination December 2024 Exam is 30/04/2025.
- Ranks are allotted first to all successful candidates qualifying for Junior Research Fellowship as per the merit list of JRF and then the candidates are distributed between CSIR and UGC in the ratio of number of fellowships shared between these two for each subject.
- There is a minimum bench mark of 33% for General, EWS & OBC category and 25% in respect of SC/ST and PwD categories for Category-1, Category-2 and Category-3.
- In case of any discrepancy, the criteria(s) mentioned in the Information Bulletin will be treated as final
